



Konstantinos Ritis is Professor in Internal Medicine and Head of the First Department of Internal Medicine & the Laboratory of Molecular Hematology of Democritus University of Thrace (DUTH). Professor Ritis graduated from Medical School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He holds the specialties of Internal Medicine and Hematology. He described novel mechanisms in thrombosis and Familial Mediterranean Fever. He is an expert on inflammation and coagulation giving numerous invited talks and tutorials and contributing at advisory boards. He is also responsible for patients who are hospitalized at the University Hospital of Alexandroupolis, as well as, for the follow up of outpatients with a large spectrum of diseases.
